1 Year Business Plan

Hay & Cow Business V T Contracting Limited

• NRKC are 75% majority shareholders in VT Contracting Limited who produce hay products for the retail market, and which use Trust land to rear and graze cattle for third party customers.

 The business is profitable for the Trust. The hay business runs out of Awakeri, while the cow grazing is on Trust land at Te Ngae farm as well as the Whakapoungakau blocks and leased land.



#### **Cow Business**

- The one-year plan is to continue with the grazing operations as they currently are, utilising the whenua as productively as possible within Nitrogen constraints imposed by Council.
- New yards have been constructed on Te Ngae farm to assist with the farming operations.



#### Hay Business

- The one-year plan is to continue with the hay baling operations as they currently stand.
- Investigations in to adding a second machine to the operations to increase production will be carried out.



#### Timberlands on Te Ngae Farm

- Timberlands will continue to lease land at Te Ngae farm for their pine nursery as well as the factory facility.
- The lease expires in 2025 at which time Timberlands will vacate the land except for the factory over which a new lease is being negotiated.





### Feasibility Study

- As part of the one year plan the Trust will look to making an application for funding to undertake a 'highest and best use' feasibility study on what the best use of the land mass could be.
- The feasibility study will take in to account the current operations, opportunities, threats, risks and rewards of potential other business operations on the whenua. This will inform the 5 year plan.


